ADMISSION CRITERIA

Baby Martin International School follows the point based system for the admissions. Those candidates secures highest points in the below parameters will be shortlisted. If the number of application exceeds than the actual open seats, a lottery draw will be conducted for the final admission in Nursery and Interaction for Class I to V.

AGE CRITERIA FOR THE ADMISSION

The school has opened the admission from class Nursery to class V. As per the National Education Policy, 2020, the age criteria would be followed for the admission as given below. *The age would be calculated as on March 31, 2022.*

Parents are advised to check the age criteria before registration for the admission.

Class of Admission	Age
Nursery	More than 3 years and less than 5 years
L - KG	More than 4 years and less than 5 years
U - KG	More than 5 years and less than 6 years
Class I	More than 5 years and less than 7 years
Class II	More than 6 years and less than 8 years
Class III	More than 7 years and less than 9 years
Class IV	More than 8 years and less than 10 years
Class V	More than 9 years and less than 11 years

Note: No relaxation will be given in terms of age criteria to any candidate.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

The school has prescribed Uniform for admitted students. The detail of the prescribed School Uniform is provided to the candidates at the time of admission.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION & RULE

Important information and rules pertaining to admission for the session 2022-23 are as given below and are part of the *Guide to Admission* which can be downloaded from the school website www.babymartin.org

The parents/guardians of candidates applying for the admission are advised to carefully read the same and it shall be presumed that they agree to abide by it.

- Parents/ Guardian can register their ward to seek the admission to a class only as per their age criteria. Any duplicate registration will be cancelled automatically without notice.
- 2. Admission to Nursery, as detailed in this guide, is open to **Indian Nationals only**.
- 3. Candidates can apply for admission to Nursery and Class I, II, III, IV and V subject to the availability of the seats.
- The School reserves the right not to admit any candidate to a class even though a notification inviting applications for admission to the same has been issued.
- The candidate shall not be entitled to claim admission as a matter of right even if he/she is otherwise eligible. The School reserves the right to refuse admission to any individual without assigning any reason.



- Use of unfair means/impersonation in Admission Test/ Interview and canvassing in any manner for securing admission shall render a candidate disqualified.
- 7. Eligibility rules as specified for each class shall be strictly followed and shall not be relaxed under any circumstance. Candidate should satisfy himself/herself that he/she fulfills the eligibility requirements prescribed for admission to the concerned class.
- 8. A candidate shall be eligible to apply for admission to a class if he/she has passed the qualifying examination (wherever required) from a recognized school and also fulfills all other eligibility requirements in terms of Transfer Certificate, age etc. If the age falls short or exceeds even by a single day, the candidate shall not be eligible for admission.
- Changes, if any, made in the Admission Rules and/or in the eligibility criteria from time to time, shall be applicable to candidates seeking admission in the School even after notification.
- 10. Application Forms may be rejected if:
 - a. Submitted incomplete.
 - b. Not submitted on prescribed form
 - c. Submitted after the last date.

and no correspondence shall be entertained in this regard. No relaxation in the last date shall be granted. The school takes no responsibility for non-submission of Application Forms or any other communication related to admissions.

- 11. Candidate should ensure that he/she possesses the proper Application Form submission Acknowledgement receipt/Admit Card before he/she reaches the Test Centre.
- 12. The medium of the Test paper shall be the Medium of Instruction as opted by the candidate in his/her Application Form.
- 13. In case any candidate who does not meet the eligibility criteria prescribed for the concerned class appears in the Admission Test, he/she shall be doing so at his/her own risk and cost, and if at any stage, it is found that the candidate does not fulfill the eligibility requirements, the admission, if granted, shall be cancelled *ipso facto*.
- 14. The lists of candidates short listed for Interview/Counselling and/or the lists of those selected for admission will be displayed on the Notice Boards of the School.
- 15. There is no hostel facility in School.



DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION

Photocopies of the following documents are required to be submitted at the time of admission along with original copy for verification.

- 1. Date of Birth certificate of the candidate attested by any of the following:
 - a. Birth certificate issued by Gram Panchayat/(BDO) or Tehsildar's sign and seal, officers of Town area or Municipal Board/local body/Municipal Corporation
 - b. Hospital/Auxiliary Nurse and Midwife (ANM) register record
 - c. Anganwadi record
 - d. Declaration of the age of the child by the parent or guardian
 - e. Certificate from the School last attended (if applicable)
- 2. Parent's Address Proof (Any one of the following)
 - a. Voter ID card
 - b. Aadhar Card
 - c. Ration Card
 - d. Latest Telephone/Electricity Bill
- Transfer Certificate/Marks-sheet from last school attended is required to be submitted (if applicable).

Note: Candidates will have to produce all relevant Certificates/Documents listed above with regard to their date of birth, special categories claimed and other relevant documents in original at the time of interaction/interview.

EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMES

The school curriculum is not based on traditional method rather it has been framed keeping in view the needs and demands of modern day context. Play way and project methods are adopted for teaching in nursery. Play-way is the only method which yields quick learning in the children. The activities done in the classes are age appropriate and focus on the all-round development of the children, i.e. physical, cognitive, language and socio emotional development.

The focus is on the overall development and environmental awareness for which the students are taken for excursion trip once a year.



Functions on religious and national festivals are conducted with fun and enthusiasm. Art and craft, music, dance, role play, puppetry, sand and water play, clay modeling are important aspect of Baby Martin International School.

On the other hand, activities are undertaken for the development of pre- reading skills for the children between 4 to 5 year age group. The purpose behind it is to prepare children for next higher grade so that they may be ready for formal education without any hesitation and fear. Children are made to practice pattern drawing, joining the dots, crayon rubbing, coloring, writing with chalk on floor, worksheets, writing alphabets, oral counting etc.

To improve the observation and memory skills, students are made to learn a variety of rhymes, songs and stories. To help gain confidence the students are also made to perform during class assemblies.

I. Happiness Curriculum

Baby Martin International School will follow the "Happiness Curriculum" in the school that focuses on the holistic development of the children.

II. Smart Class

Smart classes are introduced in our school which provides an opportunity to the children to learn through smart boards with 3D effects.

An important and distinct aspect of **Baby Martin International School** is that a record of the students will be maintained by compiling their daily work and activities including worksheets. Each student has his/her own portfolio that showcases his/her performance. This portfolio will be handed over to the student's parents/guardians at the end of the session.

Physical health record of the students will also be maintained along with their height and weight, eye sight and their physical fitness.



In addition to this, mothers will be familiarized with the demands and necessities so that they may educate and train their children in a proper way. PTM will be conducted at the end of the month to update the parents on their ward's progress and day-today activities. Besides, special parent teacher meets will be conducted twice in a year where progress report which will be prepared keeping in view the consolidated progress of the kids will be handed over to the parents and one more meeting will be conducted in the beginning of the academic year about the educational programme of the school.

Special parent teacher meet will be conducted twice a year after the half yearly and final assessment. The progress report of their wards, their overall performance is shared in the meet.

Orientation meeting will be conducted before the commencement of the session where parents/guardians will be provided with all the information regarding the syllabus, school events, schedule and all the necessary details related to their ward.
